5.7 Sun Cream and Activity Permissions

Ecclesall Kids Club understands the importance of protecting children when playing out in the sun.

In warmer weather parents will be encouraged to supply a suitable sun cream for their own child in their school bag as they do for school. Club has its own sensitive sun cream which will be available if the parent/carer has given permission for sun cream to be applied. Where a parent has not given permission the child will be asked to cover up and a club cap provided should the child wish to play outside.

Children will be supported to apply sun cream for themselves, under the guidance of club staff, where a child cannot do this for themselves, a member of staff may apply sun cream when supervised by another member of staff (for safeguarding reasons) if a parent has given permission for sun cream to be applied.

Where possible all outdoor play in warm sun will take place where there is shade, children will be monitored for signs of over exposure at all times and will be asked to reset and take drinks frequently, they will be asked to put on a club cap if necessary.

Permission for Activities

From time to time, we may undertake activities in club for which permission may be required, e.g. wearing nail varnish and face painting as well as the use of certain craft materials or performance of an activity e.g. Circus skills at Holiday club. In general permissions will be requested via Magic booking as part of set up and registration. Where a one off activity requires permission, the club will provide a permissions form.
